In the book of **Nehemiah**, God supernaturally used Nehemiah and the people of Israel to rebuild the temple walls in only **52 days**. As we prepare to rebuild the walls of our church facilities, we are taking 52 days to reflect on Scriptures to strengthen and build up our personal lives.



Just as the longest chapter in the Bible, **Psalm 119**, is arranged in an **acrostic** of the 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet, we have arranged this prayer guide into an alphabetical acrostic that goes through the English alphabet twice, for a total of 52 days.

Finding FOCUS in daily Scripture

As you read each day, consider how you can apply the truth of the Scripture to **FOCUS** in your daily walk.

FAITH

Trust in God first, and in our leaders who have been given the vision by God. 2 COR. 5:7

OTHERS

Consider others better than yourself to include those of our church's future. PHIL. 2:3

CHRIST

Christ is the center of our FOCUS. Keep your eyes on Jesus always. HEB. 12:1-2

UNITY

Focus on unity in the Holy Spirit. EPH. 4:3

SANCTIFICATION

Focus on being set apart by God for His glory in Spartanburg, South Carolina, the United States, and as far as the airwaves will carry. 1 THES. 4:1-7
